RE-GATHERING FOR WORSHIP

In March 2021, the Session formed a committee to put together the plan that the State of California required for us to re-gather for worship. This committee looked at all of the requirements that the state and CDC had listed in their various proclamations and developed a plan that allowed us to re-enter the sanctuary safely and legally. The CDC and the State of California recently reduced the restrictions, and the Session approved a change in the protocols for worship to be consistent with these new guidelines. In keeping with state mandates, we request that everyone wear masks. Other aspects of worship at TPC will return to those practices in place before the pandemic. We will continue the live stream going forward, so even if you are unable to join us in person, you can be with us online.

SCRIP NEWS




Stop by the Scrip Table after the Sunday morning worship services and support the TPC Music Program.
